In DO I was VP under Eric Solomon who became SER. Two of my DO brothers also live in LA: Danny Cohen and Harris Pinsky. I sure would like to find out the whereabouts of the other brothers from DO. My most significant memory was of a conclave in Falls Church VA. We traveled by bus which had no on board bathroom. By the time we arrived I was ready to explode so I ran into the first restroom I saw. It was filled with black people both men and women. After I relieved myself and went outside I saw there were a men's and women's rest rooms and the one I was in was labeled blacks. In the civil rights movement we heard of sit-ins and stand-ins. Mine, as far as I know, was the only PEE-IN. Another fun reminiscence: I wrote and printed (mimeographed) the chapter newsletter. One young man in the chapter was dating a girl named Hope. She had a sister named Joy. I put a one liner in the paper that read: X has hope in his heart but would prefer to have joy in bed. The shmeckel showed it to the giirls' father... We had a chapter sweetheart. She now lives in Colorado. We keep in touch.... friendships last longer than marriages. You stirred something—more keep coming to my 84 year old brain. Will keep in touch.

Steve Shapiro, Epsilon 1957

I was in Epsilon and graduated high school in 1957, a century ago!!!! We recently also started a mobile clinic program where we send a van with medical personnel and equipment to remote villages to provide modern medical care where otherwise none exists. I am getting more out of this than I am putting into it.

Bruce Donor, Epsilon, 1974

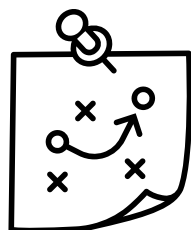

William Glazer PSER, passed away recently.

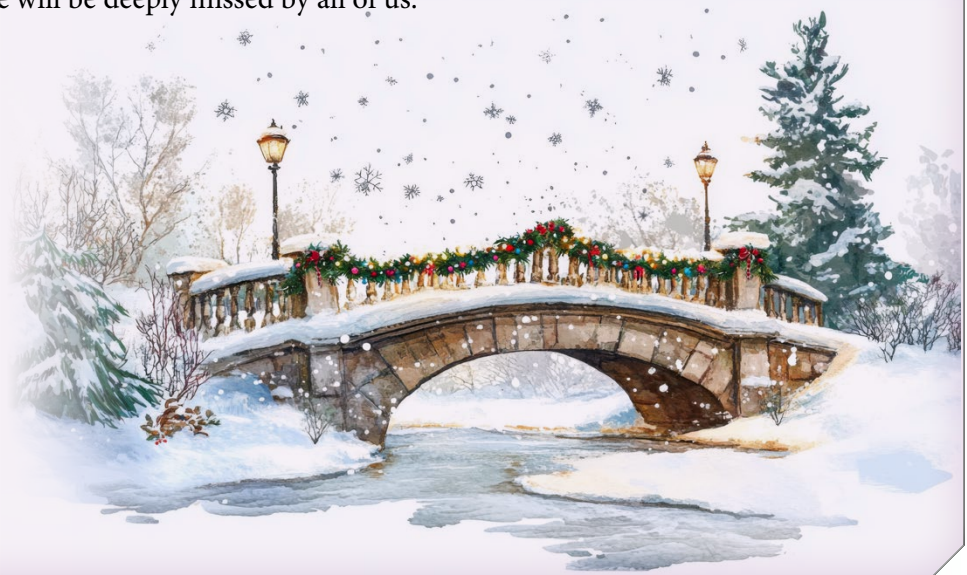
Who was he? I first met Bill (don't call me Billy) at a conclave in 1966, hosted by the brothers in the Canadian Quebec District Council (Montreal). When I arrived in Montreal, there was about a foot of snow on the streets of this fabulous city. The Exalted Ruler of the council, Bill greeted us and filled us in on the activities that are planned. Bill was a small man in stature, but it became obvious that he had total command over everything. I had some very important conversations with him, regarding the future of SAR. In other words, I like his style! We all had so much fun on the slopes of the Laurentian mountains, north of the city. Skiing, ice skating, and tobogganing with 'Duke' and Harold (Michael Carmel and Weitzberg). Bill heard the crash while he was just finishing a ski run, and came running over with a few other brothers. We accidentally hit the side of a narrow bridge. Luckily we all fell off before the crash. We were all OK nothing broke except our pride and a toboggan that looked like a giant wooden wind chime.

Bill was a leader, fair and simple. At the convention in NYC in 1967, he was elected SER. A new set of leaders on the SBC electrified the brotherhood. Leaders such as Dana Levitz, Neil Berman, Jeff Epstein, Stan Lyons Harold Heft, Michael Carmel, Harold Weitzberg, and myself. He directed us to go out and let the excitement filter down to all brothers. I spoke to Bill almost every night, and we would talk about anything and everything. When I heard that he passed I was deeply moved and in shock. We had lost contact in the 70's. Someone said he moved to California. All I know is this: SAR lost a very integral part responsible for the success we had had in the late sixties. William F. Glazer, the 56th SER. May he rest in peace, he served us well.
